




Project Remit

Design and build of 3 new stations on the Camp Hill Line:

- Moseley Village
- Kings Heath
- Pineapple Road
- 2 trains per hour to be run by West Midlands Trains (WMT) –10-15 minute journey time into Birmingham New Street.





Project Scope

- 2 x 150m platforms for 4 car trains
- 2 x 50m canopies
- Lifts
- Telecoms
- Footbridge (Kings Heath only)
- Forecourt drop off areas and urban realm
- Minor signalling changes
- Highway alterations








































































- Engage with local venues, special interest groups, resident groups, parent toddler & support groups.






